

Terms and Conditions for Granting Honorary Patronage of the AGH University Rector

1. The Honorary Patronage of the AGH University Rector is an honorary distinction that highlights the special nature and importance of the event. The honour is granted primarily to scientific and cultural events of particular significance for the university as well as for Polish science and culture.
2. The Honorary Patronage of the AGH University Rector shall not entail any financial and/or organisational support.
3. The Honorary Patronage of the AGH University Rector shall not apply to events organised exclusively by the AGH University of Krakow.
4. In case of recurring events, the Organiser shall apply for the Honorary Patronage of the AGH University Rector each time prior to the event.
5. The refusal to grant the Honorary Patronage of the AGH University Rector is final and shall not be subject to appeal.
6. The AGH University Rector shall have the right to revoke the decision to grant honorary patronage in special cases.
7. All matters related to honorary patronage are handled by the AGH University Centre for Communication and Marketing (for more information, call: 12 617 39 47).
8. The completed application for honorary patronage, i.e. Appendix No. 1 to the Terms and Conditions for Granting Honorary Patronage of the AGH University Rector, shall be submitted to the AGH University Centre for Communication and Marketing no later than four weeks prior to the planned date of the event:

9. The Organiser who is granted the Honorary Patronage of the AGH University Rector is obliged to:
 - a. inform the participants of the event that it is organised under the Honorary Patronage of the AGH University Rector;
 - b. include information about the Honorary Patronage of the AGH University Rector of a given event in all official promotional and informational materials related to the event, including communications directed to the media;

- c. place the AGH University graphic symbol in all printed materials, as well as in promotional, advertising, and informational materials (invitations, posters, fliers, etc.). [Downloadable graphic symbol](#);
- d. attach a link to the AGH University website (www.agh.edu.pl) on the website of the event;
- e. send detailed information on the planned course of the event at least 14 days before its start for potential use on the website to patronat@agh.edu.pl;
- f. provide the AGH University Centre for Communication and Marketing with invitations in case of events that require passes or tickets.
